Upper Market Corridor Safety Improvements

Project Description: The project will construct concrete corner curb extensions, or "bulbouts" to shorten pedestrian crossing distances, slow the path of vehicles turning right, and create more sidewalk space.

Complete Streets Scope: greening, lighting, site furnishing, placemaking, decorative crosswalks







Project Status: Substantial Completion in Winter 2022



Project Description: Six sidewalk extensions (four of which will include landscaped rain gardens), as well as the city's first 'raised' or traffic-calmed intersection at Page and Buchanan streets.







Page and Buchanan Intersection Work









Market Octavia Living Alleys

Project Description: The main objective of the Living Alleys program is to create safe and active public places for people, especially where there are narrow sidewalks or little open space, called living alleys. In doing so, living alleys program will add vitality to the street and to the block. Living alleys are also part of a pedestrian and bicycle network. Living alleys improve pedestrian safety by designing streets as places first and roads second by creating expectations that reinforce slower speeds and more careful driving behavior.
