Existing Conditions and Outreach Findings



High-level findings:

University of

- Local: Many specific local safety and connectivity issues can be addressed in the near term
 - Regional: Traffic congestion caused by regional vehicle demand requires mid-to-longer term strategies



Issues We Heard



Local Safety and Connectivity

- Unsafe speeds (Oak, Octavia, Gough, Laguna)
- Pedestrian crossing and signal timing (Octavia)
- Vehicles blocking transit lane (Haight)
- Livability and traffic calming (Octavia St., alleys)

Regional Congestion

- Concentration of regional traffic congestion on Oak
- Need for competitive alternative freeway access routes
- Need for regional transit options from Richmond, Sunset to East Bay, South Bay
- Need to reduce overall SOV vehicle demand


