Goals and Objectives

- Improve safety for all users
- Make biking, walking and riding transit in SoMa more comfortable
- Identify/reflect the cultural diversity and vibrancy in SoMa
- Enhance the public realm and landscape



Folsom-Howard Streetscape Project Key Points – Design



Roadway Safety

- 3 lanes → 2 lanes
- Accessible loading zones and curb ramps
- Taller vehicular oriented streetlight poles



(Folsom Streetscape)

Muni Service Improvements

- Transit boarding islands
- A transit only lane



Access and Protection Improvements

- Two-way protected bikeway with concrete buffer
- Two-Stage turn boxes
- Dedicated bicycle traffic signals
- Protected European-style intersections



Access and Protection Improvements

- Raised concrete medians with landscaping
- Curb ramps
- Raised crosswalks
- Bulb-outs and midblock signals
- Pedestrian scaled lighting
- Traffic signal upgrades



Streetscape and Cultural Amenities

- New street trees
- Placemaking amenities – historic plaques and decorative crosswalks
- Street furniture
- Upgraded water and sewer infrastructure

- **Awarded Contract (November 3, 2023)**
- **Construction (2024 to 2026)**

- Planning and Conceptual Design (2016 to 2019)
- Community Engagement (2016 to 2019)
- Legislation (2019)
- **Detailed Design (Fall 2023)**
- **Urban Realm Community Engagement (Winter 2024)**
- **Issue Contract (Approximately early 2025)**
- **Construction (Approximately late 2025 to 2027)**
