How were these strategies developed?



Community-informed

These draft Placemaking, Arts and Culture strategies are **grounded in years of community input, advocacy, and planning work** in the Fillmore / Western Addition.

This effort builds on:

- Community workshops and focus groups
- Resident experiences and lived expertise
- Existing neighborhood plans and reports
- Input from housing organizations, FCAP Steering Committee leaders, and City agencies

Why this Approach?



- Community leaders shared that residents have already voiced their priorities many times.
- Instead of asking people the same questions again, we're pulling together all the past input into one clear community action plan.
- A Community Action Plan helps everyone get on the same page, coordinate resources, and push for the investments the neighborhood needs.
