### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The proposed project would add a new two-story (10-foot) vertical addition and 25-foot horizontal addition at the rear of the existing two-story, approximately 30-foot-tall residential building with a historic storefront and bulkhead. The project would increase the number of dwelling units from two units to three, and result in a building that is approximately 3,800 square feet in size and 40 feet in height. A new roof deck is proposed with setbacks from all building walls and lightwells. The project proposes to alter the façade by removing the historic storefront and bulkhead to install a new garage door. Two off-street vehicle parking spaces are proposed within the new garage (one at grade, one below-grade).

The adoption of the MMRP is not an approval action for the project and there is no appeal process for adoption of the MMRP or Findings made at this hearing.
