Join District 8 Supervisor Rafael Mandelman and San Francisco Planning for a community forum about a potential historic landmark district designation in the Castro. San Francisco Planning staff will be on hand to discuss the landmark designation process, associated preservation incentives and responsibilities, and opportunities for public participation.

Individual Landmarks and Landmark Districts are unique and irreplaceable assets, serving to enhance and protect many of the physical surroundings in which past generations lived. Eureka Valley Commercial & Castro Village LGBTQ+ Historic District is a district of two histories, the first being early commercial development from 1879-1932, and the second being the beginning of a LGBTQ+ neighborhood beginning in 1953 and ending in 1980.

Periods of significance, boundaries, contributing properties, and character defining features, may be informed by San Francisco Survey Cultural Resource findings, adopted by the Historic Preservation Commission in December 2025.
