PRELIMINARY MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The initial evaluation conducted by the Planning Department determined that the following project could not have a significant effect on the environment, and that no environmental impact report is required. Accordingly, a Preliminary Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared.

Public recommendations for amendment of the text of the finding, or any appeal of this determination to the Planning Commission (with \$640 filing fee) must be filed with the Department within 30 days following the date of this notice. In the absence of an appeal, the Negative Declaration shall be made final, subject to any necessary modifications, 30 days from the date of this notice.

2016-011136ENV: Southeast Bay Outfall Islais Creek Crossing Replacement Project - The proposed project would improve the reliability of the Southeast Bay Outfall system, which transports treated effluent from the Southeast Water Pollution Control Plant to the San Francisco Bay. The proposed project would replace a segment of the system, comprised of two parallel pipelines that cross Islais Creek, just west of Third Street in the Bayview-Hunter's Point neighborhood. Construction of the proposed project would begin in 2021 and would take approximately 3.5 years. The site is located in the M-2 Heavy Industrial and PDR-2 Production, Distribution, and Repair Use districts. **[MOORE]**
